## Iowa Simmental Association Field Day General Rules

1. Exhibitors must have health papers in hand at check-in.
2. Tattoos of all animals will be checked in the stalls during check-in and must match American Simmental Association (ASA) registration.
3. All animals born in 2021 or before must have ORIGINAL ASA registration papers in-hand OR Electronic Papers (ASA Herdbook on your phone or tablet) (No copies or photos of papers will be allowed) NO exceptions!
4. Pre-entry is recommended, but not required. Pre-entries will close Friday, May 20 at 5:00 pm (central time). No animal substitutions to pre-entries! We encourage you to pre-enter so we can pre-fill show cards and download EPD's.

  - b. All fields on the pre-entry form are required for each animal. If any information is found to be missing or incorrect the entry will be charged the "day of" entry fee.
5. EPDs will be taken electronically from the ASA Herdbook as technology allows for the show program, the judge may use at his/her discretion (we are not a PTP show). (If technology is not available EPDs will be taken from registration papers.)
6. The show committee will break classes as needed.
7. Eligibility will be at the discretion of the ISA Board, will be final, and cannot be protested.
8. The ISA reserves the right to conduct DNA tests on the champions, reserves, or any animal in the show. Failure to comply with DNA testing will result in immediate expulsion from the show and forfeiture of prizes.
9. No artificial filling of animals will be allowed unless under advice of a licensed, non-owner veterinarian. Anyone caught artificially filling an animal without licensed non-owner vet approval will be removed from the show.
10. No changing of an animal's color pattern
11. Generators are welcome and encouraged, all generators must be run outside of the buildings.
12. Exhibitors are encouraged to utilize overhead fans if possible. Butt fans are allowed only if they are not excessive and to not infringe on others.
13. Cattle may arrive on the morning of June 4 at 7:00 am – No earlier! Cattle must be in place and checked-in by 12:00 p.m. (noon) on Saturday, June 4.
14. Stalling will be in the Cattle Barn, bedding is provided and included in entry fee for Junior Show (Open-sided building)
15. Tie-outs will be from your trailer on grass. You must bring your own bedding and you are responsible for cleaning up & removal of any bedding and trash at your tie-out area.
16. No paint can be used on the concrete floor in staging area and building connected to the showing.

# ISA Sanctioned Futurity Show Rules

## General Rules

1. Market animals or breeding heifers must have been purchased at an ISA Sanctioned Futurity Sale and either buyer or seller must have paid \$10 entry fee and filled out nomination form to be nominated for this show at the time of purchase. Nomination form and fee must be received no later than Friday, May 20 to Sherrie Moore ISA Secretary/Treasurer.
2. No additional entry fee in this division. (Iowa Juniors wishing to exhibit their futurity animal in the Junior show must pay a \$40 pre-entry/\$60 day-of entry fee and comply with the rules for that show, see below).
3. Each animal entered will be charged a \$10 common bedding fee, payable by cash or good check (unless exhibiting in Junior show as bedding is included in entry fee). NO other bedding will be allowed in barn.
4. ORIGINAL ASA registration papers in-hand OR Electronic Papers (ASA Herdbook site on your device) (No copies or photos of papers will be allowed) NO exceptions! Animal does not have to be in a junior's name to exhibit in this show.
5. Payback will be pro-rated per class from nomination fees.

6. We encourage you to pre-enter so we can pre-fill show cards and pull EPD's from the ASA Website.

## Futurity Market Animals

1. Shown by weight.
2. Must be 1/2 (50%) or higher Simmental.
3. Market animals must be born after Jan. 1, 2021.
4. Champion Futurity Market Animal will receive \$250 cash and reserve will receive \$150 cash.

## Futurity Percentage & Purebred Heifers

1. Shown by birthdate.
2. Percentage- Must be registered 1/2 – 7/8 Simmental.
3. Purebred- Must be registered 7/8 or higher Simmental.
4. Heifers must have been born between September. 1, 2020 and December 31, 2021.
5. Champion Percentage Futurity Heifer will receive \$500 cash and reserve will receive \$250 cash.
6. Champion Purebred Futurity Heifer will receive \$500 cash and reserve will receive \$250 cash.

# Junior Show Rules

## General Rules

1. Junior Show is open to all paid members of the IJSA who have not reached their 22nd birthday prior to Jan. 1, 2022. Other Iowa juniors may join for \$10.
2. This show is sanctioned by the IJBBA. All rules & membership in the IJBBA apply for receiving points and year-end awards.
3. Animal's Registration must be in the junior's name, immediate family, or family farm name that the junior is an authorized member of on the ASA Account.
4. \$40 Entry fee for pre-entered animals; \$60 day-of entry fee per animal and are due at check-in via cash or good check (entry fee includes common bedding fee) NO other bedding is allowed in the barn.
5. Payback will be pro-rated per class from entry fees.
6. Champion & Reserve will be selected in all divisions except Market Animals and both percentages of Breeding heifers.

2. Purebred- Cow must be registered 7/8 or higher Simmental.
3. Calf in either division must be 50% or higher Simmental.

## Prospect Heifer & Bull Calves

1. Shown by birthdate.
2. Must be 50% or higher Simmental.
3. If calf is not registered yet dam's registration paper must be furnished to check breed percentage and proper ownership. Dam's registration must be in junior's name, immediate family, or family farm name that the junior is an authorized member of on the ASA Account.
4. All prospect calves must have been born between January. 1, 2022 and May 1, 2022.
5. Heifers and bulls/steers will show in separate divisions.

## Junior Market Animals

1. Show by weight.
2. Market animals must be 1/2 (50%) or more Simmental.
3. Market animals must be born after Jan. 1, 2021.
4. Top five (5) market animals will be selected.

## Junior Bulls

1. Shown by birthdate.
2. All bulls must be 50% or higher Simmental.
3. All bulls must be born after Jan. 1, 2021.
4. Bulls must have registration papers at check-in.

## Junior Percentage & Purebred Breeding Heifers

1. Shown by birthdate.
2. Heifers must have been born between September 1, 2020 and December 31, 2021.
3. Percentage- Must be registered 1/2 – 7/8 Simmental.
4. Purebred- Must be registered 7/8 or higher Simmental.
5. Top ten (10) heifers will be selected in both divisions.
6. New--A Bred and Owned Overall Champion and Reserve for both purebred and percentage heifers will be selected and awarded in memory of Sammi Long. Qualifications for bred and owned will follow AJSA National Classic guidelines.

## Showmanship

1. No Entry Fee.
2. Must show your own animal in showmanship (as entered in the Junior Show). Only except for Pee-Wee Division
3. Senior – ages 14-21 as of January 1, 2022.
4. Junior – ages 13 and under as of January 1, 2022.
5. First timer – youth must be 1st-time exhibitor at the ISA Junior Field Day (May also show in Junior or Senior division for IJBBA points).
6. Awards for Champion and Reserve in each of the three divisions above will be presented.
7. Pee-Wee division – must be of "Novice age" (Under 8 on Jan. 1, 2022), not showing at Field Day, and line up own animal to show. Will show on Sunday after cattle classes. No winners will be selected but may receive something for participating. Goal is to gain experience.

## Percentage & Purebred Cow-Calf Pairs

1. Percentage- Cow must be registered 1/2 – 7/8 Simmental.
